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Executive Summary

Inmar Rx Solutions, Inc ("Inmar") was approved to operate a Safe Drug Disposal Stewardship Program ("Plan") on November 25, 2020 pursuant to the City and County of San Francisco Safe Drug Disposal Stewardship Ordinance ("Ordinance"), Chapter 22, Division 1, Sections 2200-2219 and the San Francisco Department of the Environment Regulation SFE-16-01-SDDSO. This Annual Report is for the Reporting Period between November 25, 2020 and December 31, 2021. Capitalized terms used herein are the same as those used in Inmar's approved Plan dated August 27, 2020 as revised October 13, 2020.

Inmar's primary focus for the first year of operation was to meet the convenience standard outlined in Section 2205 of the Ordinance by expanding the geographical spread of Kiosk Drop-Off Sites and Standard Mail-Back Distribution Sites. Inmar faced challenges with securing additional Kiosk Drop-Off Sites due to unique restrictions and vaccination efforts in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. In response to these challenges, Inmar sought a 90-day extension of the City and County of San Francisco's conditional approval requiring Inmar to install and begin operation of Kiosks by 90 days after signed agreements with Authorized Collectors were obtained (NOD Condition 5). This extension was granted by San Francisco on February 19, 2021. Concurrently, Inmar was approved for a 90-day extension of NOD Condition 2 providing additional time for Producers to be compliant with the approved Plan. During this reporting period, Inmar operated two Kiosks at two Drop-off Sites and 144 Standard Mail-Back Distribution Sites.

Additionally, Inmar worked with the other approved Program Operator to develop a Single System of Promotion as outlined in Section 2206 of the Ordinance. The Single System of Promotion includes uniform signage and outreach materials, the establishment of a single toll-free number and single website, and implementation of a biennial survey during applicable program years. As a result of this promotion, Inmar expects a steady increase in the number of Drop-off Sites and amount of Drugs collected in 2022.

The following information contained within this Annual Report mirrors the requirements outlined in Ordinance Section 2209.

Inmar and the other Program Operator created a single system of promotion for all promotional and outreach activities in San Francisco City and County. The Single System of Promotion ("SSP") includes a common logo, creation and implementation of a neutrally-branded website and toll-free phone number, a royalty-free license for Inmar to use the other Program Operator's kiosk signage and intellectual property, and the joint implementation of a biennial survey. In addition, the Single System of Promotion outlines a system that evenly divides Resident calls evenly between both Program Operators. In response to Section 4.3 of the Regulations, Inmar and the other Program Operator agree to evenly split all charges related to the Single System of Promotion including the neutrally-branded website creation and operation, call-center operations, biennial survey execution, and other program costs. See Appendix A for examples.

Inmar, along with the other approved Program Operator, established a joint neutrally-branded website and toll-free phone number within the reporting period. The URL for the neutrally-branded website is www.med-projectsf.org. The purpose of the joint website is to provide Residents with information pertaining to all Program Operator's disposal options and outreach material. Residents can visit the neutral website to view a map and listing of drug disposal locations including Kiosk Drop-off Sites and Standard Mail-Back Distribution Sites from all Program Operators in San Francisco. The neutral site, toll-free number, and outreach materials are available in the five required languages: English, Spanish, Russian, Chinese, and Tagalog (Filipino). This website provides direct links to both Program Operator's individually branded websites where Residents can order Mailers and find additional information on the individual Program Operators.

In conjunction with the neutral website, Inmar established an individually branded website within the reporting period. The URL for the Inmar website is www.SafeMedicineDrop.com. The website can be translated into the five required languages including English, Spanish, Russian, Chinese, and Tagalog (Filipino). Inmar's website contains identical features to the neutrally-branded website including a map and list of Kiosk Drop-off Sites and Standard Mail-Back Distribution Sites from all Program Operators in San Francisco. Residents can request that Mailers including Standard Mail-Back Envelopes, Inhaler Mail-back Envelopes, and/or Auto-Injector Mail-Back Packages be sent directly to their residence with instructions on how to return covered drugs. The website provides additional information on Inmar's Consumer Drug Take-Back Program including a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) section. See Appendix A for examples of promotional materials.

Additional outreach activities were conducted during the reporting period with the goal of meeting promotion requirements as outlined in Sections 1.3 and 1.4 of the Ordinance. These activities consisted of four influencer campaigns and one programmatic campaign. The dates and results of these campaigns are listed in Appendix B. Inmar did not meet the goals for promotion in the first year of Program Operation and are unable to determine unique impression metrics. As a result, Inmar will meet the 75% reach and frequency goals in years two and three. Inmar will utilize additional media platforms including radio and direct mail to increase awareness of safe drug disposal. The following outline the proposed promotional initiatives that



Inmar will pursue in subsequent program years to meet and exceed reach, frequency, and consumer awareness goals:

I. Outreach Materials

Inmar will provide easily-consumable educational materials for dissemination to interested parties including Residents, pharmacists, retailers, and health care practitioners upon request and at no charge. All materials will be easily understandable by interested parties with varying levels of English proficiencies and will leverage explanatory graphics to aid in comprehension. Materials will be available in English, Spanish, Russian, Chinese, and Tagalog.

These materials will:

- Provide instruction on how to safely store covered drugs at home
- Inform of the risks of disposing of Unwanted Covered Drugs in inappropriate waste streams (e.g., solid waste collection, sewer, or septic systems)
- Outline how to participate in the safe disposal of Unwanted Covered Drugs.

II. Traditional Media

Inmar has a system in place that allows us to efficiently deploy local media using traditional tactics for general program awareness. Below are details broken out by medium that cover recommended placements to reach the required 50% target audience awareness.

A. Direct Mail

Inmar will utilize direct mail (5x7 postcard) in the City and County of San Francisco in Required Languages to promote safe drug disposal and the utilization of the neutral website, www.med-projectsf.org. Direct mailings can target a combination of specific demographics including, but not limited to, certain zip codes, residential districts, health care clinics, veterinarian offices and pharmacies. Inmar plans to utilize 2022 biennial survey data to target specific zip codes and/or districts within San Francisco that demonstrated less consumer awareness of safe medicine disposal. Direct mailings can and will be translated in various languages to meet the language needs of specific communities in the City of San Francisco. Inmar aims to provide direct mailings twice a year during the months of April and October to create awareness of safe drug disposal in advance of the DEA's National Prescription Take Back Day. Direct mail postcards will illustrate the free safe drug disposal options in the City and educate consumers on how to find the nearest disposal option.

B. Radio

Radio ads provide efficient media coverage across a broad geographic area while simultaneously providing connection to the local community with known local announcers. Radio offers a frequency that reinforces messaging with listeners and drives consumer action. Different station formats offer a way to reach different target audiences. Inmar will utilize San Francisco radio station KOIT 95.6 FM ("KOIT") to provide information on safe drug disposal throughout the listening area. KOIT is consistently one of the top stations in the San Francisco radio market. Messaging will also run simulcast across streaming platforms. The utilization of KOIT radio ads have the potential to reach over 3 million impressions during a one month period. Advertisements will focus on providing education on safe drug disposal and will direct listeners to find more information on the Inmar website, www.safemedicinedrop.com. Ads will emphasize that safe drug disposal options are free to all residents of San Francisco. Radio ads can be translated in Spanish and Chinese to meet the needs of the listening area. Inmar will consider running ads on additional radio platforms in San Francisco if reach and frequency standards are not met.

III. Digital Media



A. Programmatic Media

Programmatic Media provides targeted display and/or video ads on browser sites on internet capable devices (smart phones, computers, tablets, etc.). Additionally, geo-targeting can be used to focus the ads to specific areas within proximity to a kiosk if needed to increase awareness in underserved areas or in areas that need additional outreach. Inmar will run ads across a prequalified list of over 200K domains including a variety of retail websites, Google, and Facebook. The programmatic targeted ads will run twice a year for the six weeks leading up to the DEA's National Prescription Take Back Days in April and October. Impression metrics are reported directly from the individual websites that the ads are placed on and are reported on a per campaign basis. Inmar can increase the number of programmatic campaigns utilized if reach and frequency standards are not met.

B. Influencer Marketing

Influencer Marketing is a content creation tactic used to drive awareness and education to a targeted audience through blogs and social media outlets. Influencers create original content around their everyday lives and interests while weaving the story of prescription drug take-back into their content. Influencer content is converted into paid ad units across social platforms and then targeted to community members across San Francisco. Paid advertisements for influencer content will be run on a variety of platforms including Google and Facebook and will drive towards a specified impression or reach goal. Inmar will run several social media influencer campaigns concurrently with other traditional and digital media campaigns. Inmar can recruit Spanish and Chinese speaking influencers to create content on safe drug disposal in their native language. This approach allows for certain demographics to view content that tailors to their specific language needs in an authentic way. Influencer campaigns to include one campaign every quarter. Inmar can increase the number of Influencer campaigns and paid advertisements utilized if reach and frequency standards are not met.

Collection Recycling

Ordinance SEC.2209(a)(10) - A description of how collected packaging was recycled to the extent feasible, 6 including the recycling facility or facilities used

DEA § 1317.75(c) prohibits handling substances after they have been deposited into a Kiosk. For this reason, Inmar is unable to separate and recycle drug packaging. Inmar will, however, execute educational programs, as outlined in Section VI, to encourage City residents to separate Unwanted Covered Drugs from their packaging and recycle the packaging prior to disposal.

Even though regulations prevent us from recycling drug packaging, Inmar has an interest in reducing waste and improving our environment. Through our Rx Returns and related business lines, Inmar has saved over 20,000 barrels of oil, recovered over 11,000 megawatts of clean energy, and powered over 900 homes in the past two years alone. We will continue to look for opportunities to expand our eco-friendly efforts in the City.




Figure 1 - Sample Promotional Signage




Figure 30 - www.SafeMedicineDrop.com Landing Page






Figure 31 - www.SafeMedicineDrop.com San Francisco Landing Page




Figure 32 - www.SafeMedicineDrop.com Disposal Options Nearby - San Francisco







Figure 33 - www.SafeMedicineDrop.com Mail-Back Request - San Francisco




Figure 4 - Results from Spring 2021 Influencer Campaign 1




Figure 6 - Results from Spring 2021 Influencer Campaign 2
