1. STAFF/ PERSONNEL

- Nothing to report since the last Committee Meeting on 10/25/12.

2. OUTREACH AND PRESS EVENTS

- School Education gave 10 assemblies, reaching 1744 students, since 10/25/12.

3. PROGRAM MILESTONES/ACHIEVEMENTS

- Clean Transportation: coordinated and submitted CCSF comments (Planning, MTA, Green Building team, others) to BAAQMD on draft Bay Area EV Readiness Plan, and represented SF in quarterly Bay Area EV Strategic Council meeting.
- Toxics: completed Household Hazardous Waste outreach to boaters at the SF Marina. Distributed 39 boater kits. Volunteer Kathryn Hyde entered the 2012 Dockwalker Hall of Fame and won a prize from the CA Coastal Commission for her dockwalking efforts.
- Toxics: Held Green Cleaning Event had 45 attendees to view green cleaning training videos, discussed alternative analysis of disinfectants, and Director Nutter recognized custodians who participated in the video.
- Toxics: Received Award on behalf of SFE, from Healthy Nail Salon Collaborative "Collaborative Champion Award", in honor of leadership in upholding health, safety & rights of the nail salon community.
- Zero Waste: negotiated with Fleet Week to contract with the Conservation Corps resulting in a 71% diversion rate compared to zero % last year.

4. GRANTS/FUNDRAISING

- Nothing to report since the last Committee Meeting on 10/25/12.

5. LEGISLATION

- On 10/30 the Board of Supervisors approved (10-0) the department's resolution for Expansion of Authority Regarding Lease - 1455 Market Street. The resolution authorizes the amortization of \$123,790 over the life of the lease to complete the tenant improvements required.
- On 11/1 the Budget and Finance committee approved with recommendation (3-0) the department's resolution (Mar) authorizing the department to accept and expend a onetime grant in the amount of \$2,977,000 from the California Public Utilities Commission, through PG&E, to augment the Energy Watch program.
- On 10/30 Supervisor Cohen introduced a Board Resolution recognizing the 40th Anniversary of the Federal Clean Water Act and commending the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission for Clean Water Act implementation. 6. UPCOMING EVENTS

- Assessor-Recorder press conference originally scheduled for 10/29 to announce listing green building labels on tax rolls for commercial and residential properties, will be rescheduled, new is date TBD.
