

1 **[Zero Waste Grant Awards]**

3 **Resolution approving Department of the Environment Funding Recommendations for**
4 **Zero Waste grant awards to ten organizations.**

5 WHEREAS, The Zero Waste grant program of the Department of the Environment
6 administers a grant program and provides funding to non-profit groups; and,

7 WHEREAS, the Zero Waste grant program is dedicated to funding projects diverting
8 waste from San Francisco's landfill, thereby assisting the City in achieving its goal of zero
9 waste by 2020, and achieving this at a low cost per ton of waste diverted; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, the Commission approves the award of Zero Waste grants, totaling
11 \$608,000 to be disbursed during FY 2013-2015, and a \$240,336 for an inter-departmental
12 transfer in the following way:
